- 1. Complete section 3, interrogatories.
 - 1.1. For each question, check either the "Admit" or "Deny" blocks.
 - 1.2. Add additional explanation in the "Clarification" block at the end of the question. You are also encouraged to add additional amplifying exhibits and explanation to your answers, and reference the section number and question number in your answers.
 - 1.3. Any question left unanswered shall be deemed as "Admit" and constitute a default pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 8(b)(6). To wit:
